Victory Garden Individual Borrowing Program

Victory Gardens came into popularity during World War I and World War II in an effort to ease the pressure that was placed on the public food supply. Individuals were encouraged to plant fruits and vegetables on their own and on public land. The effects of COVID-19 have resulted in a similar burden on our food supply, and as a result we are encouraging community members to empower themselves through the construction their own food gardens.

The Cincinnati ToolBank will be opening a gardening-specific inventory for individuals to borrow in order to construct and maintain a victory garden. Tools will be available to borrow through October 31st.

Program Guidelines

- Tools may only be borrowed in order to create and maintain a victory garden.
- Tools are limited to the Tools on the Tool Order list below.
- Tools may not be loaned to other individuals, organizations and/or companies at any time.
- Project request along with a complete application must be e-mailed to
 kristina.anderson@toolbank.org at least 3 business days prior to requested pickup an
 Cincinnati ToolBank staff person will contact back in 1 business day if approved, to give the
 availability of tools, and pickup confirmation.
- Tool Use Agreement Form and Victory Garden Project Application must be signed by borrower prior to use of tools.
- Tools may be kept for 1 week max, unless otherwise approved.
- Cincinnati ToolBank has right to deny any tool request submission for any reason
- There will be no fees charged to borrow the tools, but the Cincinnati Community ToolBank reserves the right to request a deposit for the tools borrowed.
- Individuals are responsible for the cost to replace any damaged or lost tools.
- All tool borrowers must complete the Victory Garden Proposal and sign the Waiver form.
